

# REMOTE PRE HOSPITAL TRAUMA & DISASTER COURSE (RPHTDC)

**LOCATION:** Alice Springs 15<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> September 2021

This is a 2 day course for personnel who routinely attend pre-hospital incidents by providing participants with the theoretical knowledge and practical skills to safely and effectively manage trauma or disaster patients in the pre- hospital environment.

**BY THE END OF THE COURSE PARTICIPANTS WILL BE ABLE TO:**

- Demonstrate the assessment & effective management of a vehicle crash scene
- Demonstrate the assessment & effective management of trapped casualties
- Demonstrate the safe extrication of trapped casualties
- Discuss the importance of & demonstrate working effectively within a team setting
- Demonstrate the triage sort & sieve, treatment & transport principles used within mass casualty incidents

Remote area health personnel, ambulance auxiliary, General Practitioners, medical & nursing professionals, retrieval specialists, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Health Practitioners (ATSIHPs), emergency services, mine rescue and the Australian Defence Force health personnel.
